



Pupil Premium Review Statement 2016-2017

The Pupil Premium was introduced in April 2011. It is Government funding allocated to schools for pupils who are or who have been eligible for free school meals in the previous 6 years. The level of premium for 2017/18 is £1,320. Looked after children or those adopted from care on or after 30th December 2005 are allocated £1900 and pupils with a parent in the Armed Forces attract £300. The funding is used to narrow any gaps in attainment between these pupils and their peers.

The Pupil Premium allocated to Marus Bridge Primary School for 2016/2017: 72,888

The estimated allocation expected by school for 2017/18: £79,620
