Some children in Rec and Y1 don't want to take part.</b> What can we do about it?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Present an assembly to Rec and Y1 on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> December @ 9:30am. (JD, LMS, GW, HP, GB and NM to speak.)</li> <li>• Persuade children it is FUN and will help them with their reading.</li> <li>• Ask Rec and Y1 teachers to promote it in class.</li> <li>• Ask children what books they would like to read.</li> <li>• Encourage Rec and Y1 children to bring in books they would like to share.</li> <li>• Give stickers to Rec and Y1 children that take part.</li> </ul> <p><b>2. Some children in Y2-Y6 are not following the rota.</b> What can we do about it?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• School Councillors to check the rotas daily and remind children of their shifts.</li> <li>• School Councillors to hand out reading buddy lanyards at the start of lunch time and collect them at the end of lunchtime. This will identify the children who are on a shift that day.</li> </ul> <p>MS and GB are to write a proposal to Mr Gaskill asking for money to buy stickers and lanyards (28 in total) for reading buddies to use.</p>
<b>Second thing we are going to talk about:</b>	
How are we going to raise money for our next objective: buying better stationery / planners?	<p>Lots of ideas for fundraising included the following: old books / toys sale, cake sale, teddy bears picnic, themed own clothes day, pyjama day and movie day.</p> <p>School Councillors will speak to their classes about fundraising and bring ideas to the next meeting.</p>
